

Appendix No. 8: Rules of the Board Game Service

Reading these Rules is mandatory for all users of the service.

- **Liability:** Board games may be used at the users' own responsibility.
- **Health condition:** The games may only be used by library users who are healthy and sober.
- **Hygiene:** The games may only be used with clean hands.
Restroom facilities are available on the premises.
- **Prohibited items and activities:** Smoking, open flames, sharp objects, and firearms are prohibited; obscene language and discriminatory behavior are also forbidden.
- **Food and drinks:** Bringing food and drinks into the room is prohibited, except for sealed bottles.
- **Damages:** Users are required to compensate for any damages caused.
- **Minors:** Persons under the age of 18 may only play under the supervision of a parent, legal guardian, or teacher (the person over 18 assumes responsibility for the minor).
- **Game inspection:** Users are required to check all board game components before leaving.
- **Tidiness:** After use, the games must be neatly arranged and returned to their original place.

By following these rules, everyone contributes to ensuring uninterrupted gameplay for themselves and for the next group.

In the event of violation of these Rules, users may be banned from the library.

By registering, players automatically accept the rules of the board game service.
